Earlier this year, we surveyed employers across Upstate New York and asked them a series of questions about the state's business climate. The following responses focus on employers' perspectives on the impacts of policies enacted during the 2019 legislative session.


WHAT ISSUES DO YOU FEEL HAVE THE MOST IMPACTS ON NEW YORK'S BUSINESS CLIMATE?
